STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to copying Plans of Maine towns and
indexing Records and Plans in the Land Office.

Resolved, That the land agent be and hereby is directed
2 to continue the work of copying the old plans of Maine
3 towns now in the archives of the State of Massachusetts
4 and that the sum of one thousand dollars be appropriated
5 for that purpose.

Also that the land agent be and hereby is directed to
7 have the plans and records in the land office properly
8 indexed.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

There are over three hundred plans of Maine towns still in the Massachusetts archives of which we have no copies in the land office and it seems an absolute necessity to have such copies.
