IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

---

AN ACT entitled "An Act to amend Section 41 of Chapter  
238 of the Public Laws of 1889, relating to the taking of  
Migratory Fish."

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows.*

Section 41 of chapter 238 of the Public Laws of 1889, is  
2 amended by adding after the word "dam" in the thirteenth  
3 line thereof, the following words: "And provided, also,  
4 that fly-fishing shall be allowed up to within fifty feet of the  
5 dam across the Aroostook river in the town of Caribou.  
6 So that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:  
    'No salmon, shad or other migratory fish, shall be taken  
8 or fished for, within five hundred yards of any fish-way,  
9 dam or mill-race; nor between the Bangor and Brewer  
10 bridge over the Penobscot river and the water works

11 dam at Treat's falls on said river; nor between the  
12 Augusta highway bridge over the Kennebec river and the  
13 Augusta dam between the first days of April and Novem-  
14 ber, except by the ordinary mode of angling with a single  
15 hook and line, or artificial fly; nor shall hook and line  
16 or artificial flies be used at any time within one hundred  
17 yards of any fish-way, dam or mill-race; provided that  
18 fly-fishing shall be allowed up to the bridge across Denny's  
19 river at Lincoln's mill, but not between said bridge and  
20 Lincoln's mill dam; and provided, also, that fishing  
21 with an artificial fly or single baited hook and line shall  
22 be allowed up to within fifty feet of the dam across the  
23 Aroostook river in the town of Caribou. The penalty for  
24 violation of this section is a fine of not more than fifty  
25 nor less than ten dollars for each offence and a further  
26 fine of ten dollars for each salmon and one dollar for each  
27 shad so taken.'
