STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section twenty-three, Chapter one hundred sixteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to the Regulation of Fees and Costs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section twenty-three of chapter one hundred sixteen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

‘Section 23. For entering and recording intentions of marriage, giving certificate of same and recording marriage on receiving the minister’s or justice’s certificate thereof, one dollar to be paid on issuing the certificate of intention. For recording births and deaths, ten cents

- 9 each. For a certificate of a birth or death, ten cents.
- 10 For recording sheep marks, ten cents.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
