IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section twenty-three, Chapter one hundred sixteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to the Regulation of Fees and Costs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section twenty-three of chapter one hun-
- 2 dred sixteen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended
- 3 so as to read as follows:
 - 'Section 23. For entering and recording intentions of
- 5 marriage, giving certificate of same and recording mar-
- 6 riage on receiving the minister's or justice's certificate
- 7 thereof, one dollar to be paid on issuing the certificate of
- 8 intention. For recording births and deaths, ten cents

- 9 each. For a certificate of a birth or death, ten cents.
- 10 For recording sheep marks, ten cents.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
