STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT authorizing the city of Saco to remove the Bodies
of Persons deceased now interred in Pepperrell Park,
Saco.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The city of Saco in the county of York is
2 hereby authorized, whenever its city council shall so vote
3 to take such action as shall be deemed proper and expe-
4 dient by said council for the disinterment, removal and
5 care of the dead bodies now lying in Pepperrell Park, so
6 called, in said Saco; and in case such bodies are to be
7 removed said city is likewise authorized to procure and
8 purchase suitable lots in some cemetery or cemeteries for
9 their interment, and attend to the proper re-setting of

10 any and all grave-stones now standing in said Pepperrell
11 Park, and to do anything or things necessary to a proper
12 and decent care of said bodies, and in case it is decided
13 by said council not to remove such bodies said city is
14 hereby authorized upon a vote of said council therefor to
15 so arrange that part of said park where said bodies now
16 are as may be deemed consistent and in harmony with
17 the other arrangements of said park.

SECT. 2. Said city of Saco is hereby authorized to
2 raise such sums of money by loan or taxation as may be
3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this act.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
