### STATE OF MAINE.

#### RESOLVE in favor of Eliza A. Poor.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the State treasury,

- 2 to Eliza A. Poor of Brownfield, a pension of six dollars
- 3 per month beginning January one, eighteen hundred and
- 4 ninety-three.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Eliza A. Poor of Brownfield, Me., is the widow of the late William Poor, deceased, who was granted a State pension by the Legislature of 1891, and received the same until his death about a year ago. Mrs. Poor, his widow, is an old lady, nearly seventy-five years old, and is dependent almost solely upon her own labor, washing clothing, for her maintenance.
