IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to extend the Charter of the Ellsworth Street Rail-
way Company.

WHEREAS it seems desirable that the charter of the Ells-
worth Street Railway Company be hereby extended and that
it have right in express terms to cross the tide waters of
Union river in said Ellsworth, therefore,

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the
2 Ellsworth Street Railway Company which were granted
3 by chapter three hundred and ninety-one of the Private
4 and Special Laws for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-
5 nine, are hereby extended for two years additional; and
6 the persons named in said act shall have all the rights,

7 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act
8 to be exercised in the same manner, and for the same pur-
9 poses, as provided in this act.

SECT. 2. Said Ellsworth Street Railway Company for
2 the purposes and objects of its charter is hereby expressly
3 granted the right to cross the tide waters of Union river,
4 so called, within the limits of the city of Ellsworth upon
5 bridges of said city or upon bridges of said company
6 erected therefor—*provided, however*, that said railway
7 company shall not unnecessarily obstruct navigation and
8 that the manner and conditions of its so crossing said
9 river upon either of such bridges, and of its erecting and
10 maintaining any bridges of its own shall first be deter-
11 mined by the municipal officers of said city.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
