IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to extend the Charter of the Ellsworth Street Rail-

way Company.

WHEREAS it seems desirable that the charter of the Ellsworth Street Railway Company be hereby extended and that it have right in express terms to cross the tide waters of Union river in said Ellsworth, therefore,

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the 2 Ellsworth Street Railway Company which were granted 3 by chapter three hundred and ninety-one of the Private 4 and Special Laws for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-5 nine, are hereby extended for two years additional; and 6 the persons named in said act shall have all the rights,

7 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act
8 to be exercised in the same manner, and for the same pur9 poses, as provided in this act.

SECT. 2. Said Ellsworth Street Railway Company for 2 the purposes and objects of its charter is hereby expressly granted the right to cross the tide waters of Union river, 3 so called, within the limits of the city of Ellsworth upon 4 bridges of said city or upon bridges of said company 5erected therefor-provided, however, that said railway 6 company shall not unnecessarily obstruct navigation and 7 8 that the manner and conditions of its so crossing said river upon either of such bridges, and of its erecting and 9 10 maintaining any bridges of its own shall first be deter-11 mined by the municipal officers of said city.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
