IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

---

AN ACT for the better protection of Deer in the Counties  
of Cumberland, Lincoln, Waldo, and York.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Whoever, in any manner or at any time  
2 within two years of the approval of this act, shall hunt,  
3 chase, catch, kill or destroy any deer within the counties  
4 of Cumberland, Lincoln, Waldo or York forfeits forty  
5 dollars for each deer so hunted, chased, killed or destroyed.

SECT. 2. All the provisions of chapter thirty of the  
2 Revised Statutes relating to deer, not inconsistent with  
3 this act are hereby made a part of this act.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
