## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to ratify and make valid the oaths of the Selectmen and Assessors of Franklin, Maine, for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-five, eighteen hundred and eighty-six, eighteen hundred and eighty-seven and eighteen hundred and eighty-nine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Whereas, it appears that the selectmen and

- 2 assessors of Franklin, Hancock county, Maine, for the
- 3 respective years A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty-five,
- 4 A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty-six, and A. D. eighteen
- 5 hundred and eighty-seven were duly and properly sworn
- 6 and that the town records thereof are defective and that
- 7 the selectmen and assessors of the same town for the year

- 8 A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty-nine were sworn by
- 9 the moderator at the A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty-
- 10 nine annual town meeting; now therefore be it enacted
- 11 that the several oaths actually taken in the premises are
- 12 sufficient in law and that they have the same force and
- 13 effect as if duly taken, filed and recorded as the law
- 14 required.
- SECT. 2. This act shall not affect any action at law or 2 equity heretofore instituted.
