STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section thirty-three of Chapter seventysix of the Revised Statutes, relating to Levy by Execution.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirty-three of chapter seventy-six of the Revised 2 Statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word 3 "printed" in the last line of said section the words 'in 4 whole or in part' so that said section, as amended, shall 5 read as follows:

'Section 33. The officer in such case shall give written 7 notice of the time and place of sale, to the debtor in per-8 son, or by leaving the same at his last and usual place of 9 abode, if known to be an inhabitant of the State, and 10 cause it to be posted in a public place in the town where

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11 the land lies, and in two adjoining towns, if so many adjoin; and if the land is situated in two or more towns, 12 then in each of those towns, and in two towns adjoining 1314 each of them; and if the land is in two or more counties, an officer in either county may sell the whole right. 15When the land is not within any town, the notice shall 16 be posted in two public places of the shire town of the 17 18 county in which the land lies, instead of the posting 19 aforesaid. When the debtor is not a resident of such 20 county, the personal notice may be forwarded to him by mail, postage paid; all to be done thirty days before the 21 day of sale. The notice shall also be published for three 22 weeks successively before the day of sale, in a newspaper 2324 printed in whole or in part in such county, if any, other-25 wise in the State paper.'
