STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section thirteen of Chapter eighty-seven
of the Revised Statutes, relating to actions by or against
Executors and Administrators.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section thirteen of chapter eighty-seven of the Revised
2 Statutes is amended by striking out the first sentence
3 thereof which reads as follows: "A creditor who was
4 absent from the State during said two years, and had no
5 sufficient attorney in the State, may make presentment
6 and demand of his claim, and after thirty days may com-
7 mence his action, within six months from his return, or
8 the appointment of such attorney," so that said section
9 as amended shall read as follows :

‘Section 13. When assets come into the hands of an
11 executor or administrator after said term of two years,
12 presentment and demand may be made by a creditor, and
13 after thirty days an action may be commenced, within
14 two years from the receipt of such assets and within six
15 months after the creditor has notice thereof. Judgment
16 rendered in any action authorized by this section, shall
17 not disturb payments made in good faith by the executor
18 or administrator prior to presentment of the claim sued
19 in such action.’
