IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to set off a portion of the town of Camden and
annex the same to the town of Rockport.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The following tract of land is hereby set
2 off from the town of Camden and annexed to the town of
3 Rockport: Beginning at the sea or Penobscot bay on
4 the original northerly line of the Daniel Barrett farm,
5 thence north forty-five degrees west one hundred and
6 thirty rods or thereabouts to the easterly line of the J.
7 W. Ogier farm; thence north forty-four degrees east by
8 said line thirty rods to an angle in the fence; thence
9 north fifty-two degrees east about thirty rods to the north-
10 west corner of the Bay Cemetery; thence southeasterly

11 by the northerly line of said cemetery to the sea, or
12 Penobscot bay; thence southerly by the sea to the place
13 of beginning.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
