IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 266 of the Laws of 1867,
relating to the Camden Village Corporation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 266, Acts of 1867,
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Camden"
3 in said section the words 'excepting so much of said
4 school district as is now within the limits of the town of
5 Rockport', so that said section as amended shall read as
6 follows:

'Section 1. The territory embraced within the limits of
8 Megunticook school district in the town of Camden,
9 excepting so much of said school district as is now within
10 the limits of the town of Rockport, together with the
11 inhabitants thereon, be and the same is hereby created a

12 body politic and corporate, by the name of the Camden
13 Village Corporation.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
