STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Farmington State Normal School.

Resolved, That, for the improvement of the heating and
2 ventilation of the Farmington State Normal School build-
3 ing and for necessary repairs and furniture, there be, and
4 hereby is appropriated for the year eighteen hundred and
5 ninety-three, the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars
6 (\$2,500), and for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
7 four, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500), the
8 same to be expended under the direction of the board of
9 trustees of State Normal Schools.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The board of Normal School trustees asked for an appropriation of \$30,000, to enlarge the assembly room of the Normal School building at Farmington and put in suitable heating and ventilation. On account of the condition of the finances of the State the committee feel obliged to report reference to the next legislature, provided the accompanying resolve receives a passage.

After hearing the trustees and having a communication placed before them from Prof. Robinson of the State Board of Health who had made an official examination of the building with reference to its heating and ventilation, it seems imperative that some relief should be given at once, and we recommend an appropriation for improving the heating and ventilation of \$3,500. Necessary repairs and furniture, \$500.
