STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to fix the salary of the Register of Deeds for
Penobscot County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The register of deeds for Penobscot county
2 shall receive an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars,
3 and an additional allowance of one thousand dollars per
4 year for clerk hire; said salary to be paid from the county
5 treasury and to be instead of the fees now provided by
6 law, which fees shall be paid into the county treasury for
7 the use of said county.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect April first, A. D.
