#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

GRAY, March 4, 1893.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled:

Please allow me to petition your honorable bodies to place me on the pension book of the State, as I served in the Second New Hampshire Regiment, Co. D, was discharged at City Point, Va., Dec. 19, 1865. Have always lived in Gray, except during my service in the army.
