IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Paragraph nine, Section fifty-nine of Chapter three, Revised Statutes, relating to the regulation of Vehicles used in towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Paragraph nine, section fifty-nine of chapter three,

- 2 Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by adding and
- 3 inserting after the word "therein" in the fourth line of
- 4 said paragraph the words 'or, if there is no newspaper
- 5 printed therein, such by-laws and ordinances shall be
- 6 posted at least one week before they take effect, in two
- 7 public and conspicuous places therein and published in
- 8 some newspaper printed in the county in which said town

'IX.

9 is situated,' so that said paragraph as amended shall read
10 as follows:

For the regulation of all vehicles used therein,

- 12 by establishing the rates of fare, routes and places
 13 of standing, and in any other respect; but by-laws
 14 and ordinances for this purpose shall be published one
 15 week at least before they take effect, in some newspaper
 16 printed therein, or, if there is no newspaper printed
 17 therein, such by-laws and ordinances shall be posted at
 18 least one week before they take effect, in two public and
 19 conspicuous places therein and published once in some
- 20 newspaper printed in the county in which said town is
- 21 situated; and penalties for their breach shall not exceed
- 22 twenty dollars for one offence, to be recovered by com-
- 23 plaint to the use of such city, town or corporation.'
