STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to embezzlement of property the subject
of larceny.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Whoever embezzles, or fraudulently converts to his own
2 use, or secretes with intent to embezzle or fraudulently
3 convert to his own use, money, goods, or property de-
4 livered to him, or any part thereof, which may be the
5 subject of larceny, shall be deemed guilty of larceny.
