STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section 1 of Chapter 298 of Public Laws
of 1889, relating to Hawkers and Peddlers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Amend section 1 of chapter 298 of Public Laws of 1889
2 by inserting in the fifth line thereof, after the word
3 "fuel," the following words, to wit: 'maps, brushes,
4 pictures and photographs of places and persons,' so that
5 said section as amended shall read as follows, to wit:

'Section 1. No person shall go about from town to
7 town, or from place to place in the same town, exposing
8 for sale or selling any goods or chattels other than fruit
9 grown in the United States, fruit trees, provisions, live
10 animals, brooms, agricultural implements, fuel, maps,

11 brushes, pictures and photographs of places and persons,
12 newspapers, books, pamphlets, agricultural products of
13 the United States, the products of his own labor or the
14 labor of his family, any patent of his own invention, or in
15 which he has become interested by being a member of
16 any firm, or stockholder in any corporation which has
17 purchased the patent, until he shall have procured a
18 license so to do as hereinafter provided.'
