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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE,

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AN ACT to amend Section fourteen of Chapter fifteen of  
the Revised Statutes, relating to Burying Grounds.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section fourteen of chapter fifteen of the  
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding to said section  
3 the following : 'Any city or town without giving bond there-  
4 for may be appointed by the probate court testamentary  
5 trustee for the purpose of holding forever in accordance  
6 with the provisions of this section and the terms of the  
7 devise, any fund devised for the purposes aforesaid.'

SECT. 2. The provisions of the foregoing amendment  
2 shall apply to wills which have been probated since Jan-  
3 uary 1st, 1892.
