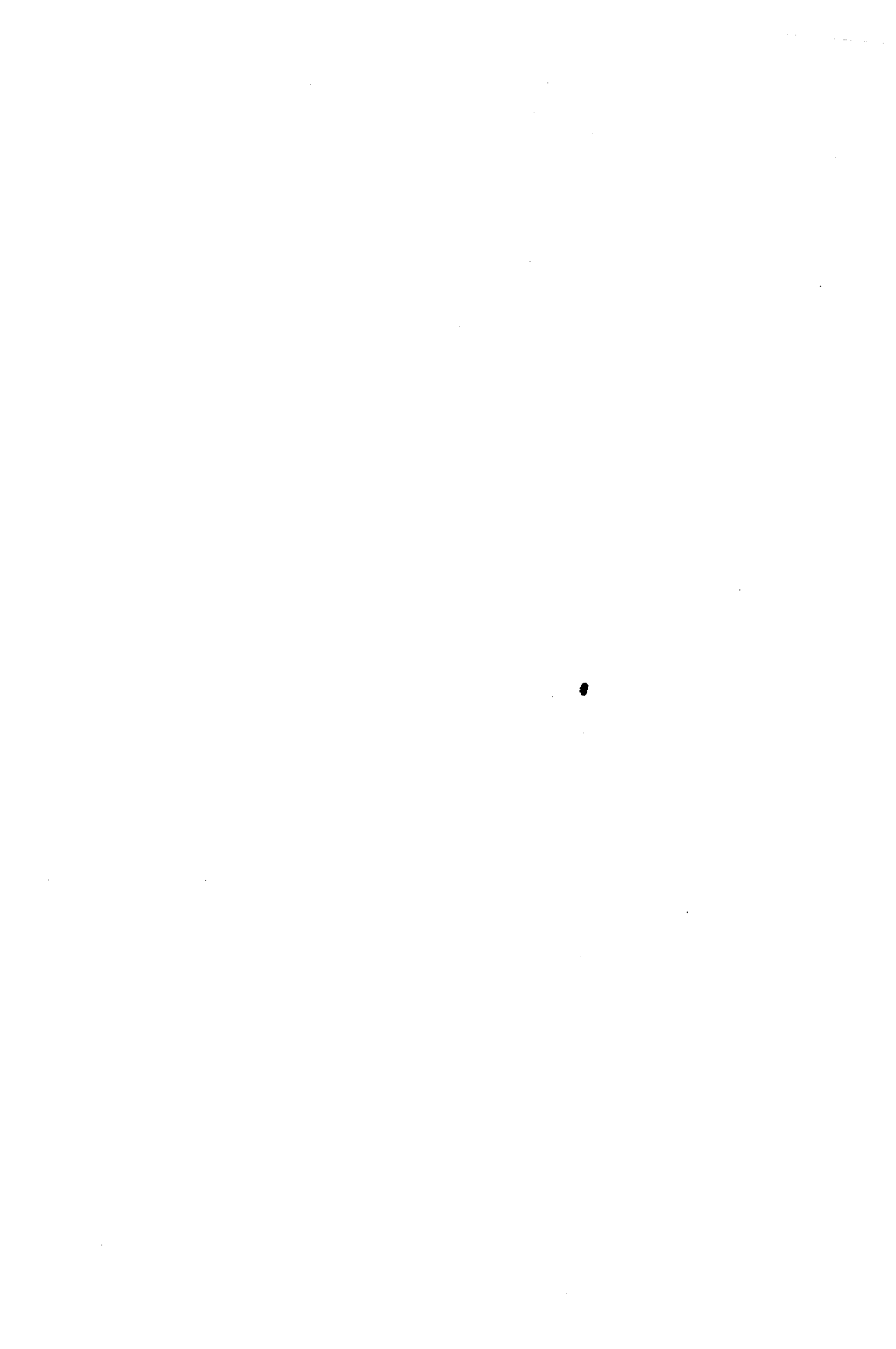
AN ACT to amend Section 44 of Chapter 20 of the Revised
Statutes, relating to the publication of the Public Laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Amend section forty-four, chapter two, of the Revised
2 Statutes, by inserting in the third line of said section,
3 after the word "paper," the words 'in good, clear, non-
4 pareil type,' so that said section amended shall read as
5 follows:

'He shall cause the public laws passed at each session to
7 be printed within thirty days after the close thereof, in
8 extra sheets, on good paper, in good, clear, nonpareil
9 type, by the publishers of each newspaper, and each
10 printer who so publishes and distributes the laws to his

11 subscribers shall receive ten dollars, besides one dollar
12 for every hundred copies so distributed. He shall also
13 procure the usual number of Maine Reports, and distrib-
14 ute them and the acts and resolves when published to
15 such corporations, officers and other persons as the legis-
16 lature designates.'
