STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prevent the destruction of smelts in the harbors,
coves and inlets in the town of Bluehill.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from
2 taking any smelts within one-half mile of the entrance of
3 any harbor, cove or inlet in the town of Bluehill, in the
4 County of Hancock, by means of purse or drag seines, or
5 by weirs.

SECT. 2. Whoever shall violate the provisions of this
2 act, shall, on conviction of the same before any municipal
3 court or trial justice of said County of Hancock, be
4 punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars, nor more

5 than twenty dollars, or imprisonment in the county jail
6 for a term not less than ten days, and imprisoned in said
7 jail for same time for non-payment of said fine.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
