- 2 to the town of Wales, the sum of eight dollars and eighty
- 3 cents (\$8.80) it being a balance equitably due said town
- 4 on account of bounty paid on crows.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Wales, February 25, 1893.

I paid from the treasury in Wales, year eighteen ninety, as bounty on crows, eight dollars and eighty cents and forwarded certificates and receipts to treasurer's office, Augusta in December mailing same at Sabatis post office. But found on paying State tax that the above notice was not received at the treasurer's office consequently it was not allowed.

We ask to have the above amount refunded to the town.
