STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the County of Cumberland to negotiate a loan for the alteration and repair of Portland Bridge, as required by the War Department.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The county of Cumberland is hereby
2 authorized to negotiate a loan not exceeding forty thou-
3 sand dollars exclusive of and in addition to loans author-
4 ized by chapter 302, of the acts of 1889, necessary for the
5 purpose of building a new draw on "Portland Bridge,"
6 and for making such other changes in said bridge as the
7 War Department may require.

SECT. 2. Said loan shall become payable within ten
2 years from June 1, 1893, at such times as the county com-
3 missioners may appoint, and shall bear interest at the rate
4 of four per cent per annum, payable semi-annually.

SECT. 3. The county treasurer is hereby authorized,
2 under the direction of the county commissioners in order
3 to procure said loan, to issue eighty bonds of the county
4 of Cumberland with interest coupons attached, of the
5 denomination of five hundred dollars each, dated June 1,
6 1893, payable to bearer, at such times within ten years as
7 the county commissioners may appoint.

SECT. 4. Said bonds and coupons shall be signed by
2 the county treasurer, and said bonds shall be countersigned
3 by the county commissioners of said county, and shall be
4 sold by the treasurer at the highest price that he can
5 obtain, not less than par; and the proceeds of the same
6 shall be applied for the purposes aforesaid and for none
7 other.
