# STATE OF MAINE.

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT providing for the form of warrant for the commitment of taxes under the provisions of Sections one hundred and forty-seven and one hundred and forty-nine of Chapter six of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The warrant to be issued by the assessors for the com-2 pletion of the collection of taxes under the provisions of 3 sections one hundred and forty-seven and one hundred 4 and forty-nine of chapter six of the Revised Statutes shall 5 be in substance as follows :

ss. A. B., constable, or collector of the town

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within the county of

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby 9 required to levy and collect of such of the several persons 10 named in the list herewith committed unto you, his respec-11 tive proportion therein set down, of the sum total of such 12 list, amounting in the aggregate to dollars and 13 cents, it being the unpaid portion of the taxes assessed 14 in the town of for the year , for State, county and town purposes, and to pay the same to 15 16 treasurer of said town of , or to his succes-17 sor in office, and to complete and make an account of 18 your collections of the whole sum on or before the 19 day of next. And if any person refuses or neglects to pay the sum which he is assessed in said list, 20 you will distrain his goods or chattels to the value 21 thereof. And in making such distress, and for want of goods and chattels, whereon to make distress, except

20 neglects to pay the sum which he is assessed in said list, 21 you will distrain his goods or chattels to the value 22 thereof. And in making such distress, and for want of 23 goods and chattels, whereon to make distress, except 24 such as are exempt by the provisions of section 122 of 25 chapter 6 of the Revised Statutes, you will in all matters 26 proceed as prescribed in section 122 of chapter 6 of the 27 Revised Statutes as fully as if the same were herein set 28 forth.
