RESOLVE for the payment of witnesses, magistrates, officers, and disbursements of the Committee on Elections in the Phillips' contested election case.

*Resolved,* That the State treasurer be and is hereby  
2 authorized and instructed to pay to Frank O. Purington,  
3 chairman of the committee on elections the sum of fifty-  
4 four dollars and thirty-three cents to be used by said  
5 Purington in paying the fees of witnesses, magistrates and  
6 officers on the part of the sitting member and the disburse-  
7 ments of the committee incident to said hearing.
