STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the setting of Lobster Traps with-
in certain limits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

All persons are hereby prohibited from setting any lob-
ster trap or traps within three hundred feet of the mouth
or outer end of the leaders of any fish weir, under a pen-
alty of five dollars for each offence, to be recovered on
complaint before any court of competent jurisdiction in
the county where the offence is committed, one-half to the
use of the complainant and one-half to the use of said
county.
