STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Cutler in Washington county, for aid in building Roads and Bridges.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be appropriated to the town of Cutler in Washington county, to aid in building roads and bridges, or applied to liquidating debts contracted for this purpose, the same to be applied to this purpose under the direction of county commissioners of said county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The county commissioners of Washington county in laying out a road leading from Lubec to Whitney laid a portion of said road through the town of Cutler which cost the town three thousand dollars to build, which is of no particular value to our town but which we were compelled to build for the benefit of the above named towns and other sections. We have thirty-six miles of road in our town with two bridges to build the present season, and a large town debt, which burdens seem more than we can bear.

Valuation of town, \$70,000; rate per cent of taxes, five per cent; bonded indebtedness, \$10,000.
