IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Section 13, Chapter 95, of the Public
Laws of 1891, relating to transportation of Game.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 13, chapter 95 of the Public Laws of 1891 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the following words after
3 the word "thereof" in the fifth line, "and accompanied by
4 him," so that said section as amended shall read as follows :

‘Section 13. No person or corporation shall carry or
6 transport from place to place any moose, caribou or deer
7 or part thereof in close time nor in open time unless open
8 to view, tagged and plainly labeled with the name of the
9 owner thereof under a penalty of forty dollars ; and any
10 person not the actual owner of such game or part there-

11 of, who, to aid another in such transportation falsely rep-
12 resents himself to be the owner, shall be liable to the
13 penalties aforesaid.'

REPORT "A."
