STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to Paupers not having any legal settlement within the State.

Resolved, That the Board of State Assessors are hereby
2 directed to cause an investigation to be made of the
3 number of paupers in the several towns and cities of the
4 State not having any legal settlement within the State and
5 the amounts such towns and cities annually expend for the
6 care of such paupers by sending to the overseers of the
7 poor of each town and city proper blanks of inquiry
8 relating to the same. They shall then report their findings
9 to the next legislature.
