HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" TO HOUSE DOCUMENT No. 265.

Amend by inserting in section six, line sixteen, after the word "county," 'with the number of voters' names appearing on the voting list at the annual meeting in the same year.' And in the eighteenth line of the same section, after the word "the," 'registered voters cast their vote,' so that said section shall read :

'Section 6. The list prepared for annual city or town
2 meetings in 1893, revised as lists for annual town meet-
3 ings are revised as provided in the statutes of this
4 State, shall be used at such meetings and the same pro-
5 ceedings to be had as is provided for such city, town or
6 plantation meetings, and they shall be warned, notified
7 and held in the same manner as other city, town and

8 plantation meetings. At said meetings the legal voters
9 shall vote by ballot on said question, those in favor of
10 the same expressing it by the word "yes" upon their
11 ballot, and those opposed thereto expressing it by the
12 word "no" upon their ballot the ballots shall then be
13 received, counted and declared in city, town and planta-
14 tion meeting and lists of the votes so received shall be
15 made and returned to the clerk of the county commission-
16 ers at Machias in said county, with the number of voters
17 names appearing on the voting list at the annual meeting
18 in the same year, the same as in State elections, the
19 county commissioners shall count the same, declare and
20 record the result. If a majority of all the registered
21 voters cast their vote in the affirmative then the county
22 commissioners and county treasurer of said Washington
23 county shall have full authority and shall within ten days
24 thereafter, in the name of said county and in its behalf,
25 execute and deliver to said company the agreement of
26 said county to subscribe and pay for three hundred
27 thousand dollars of the stock of said railroad company
28 as provided in section two of this act.'
