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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

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AN ACT to abolish the trial fee in civil suits in the municipal court of Waterville.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The trial fee of one dollar in civil suits  
2 now required by law to be paid by plaintiff in the municipal court of Waterville is hereby abolished.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby modified so as to conform to the provisions of this act.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
