
## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to abolish the trial fee in civil suits in the municipal court of Waterville.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The trial fee of one dollar in civil suits
- 2 now required by law to be paid by plaintiff in the muni-
- 3 cipal court of Waterville is hereby abolished.
  - SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent here-
- 2 with are hereby modified so as to conform to the provi-
- 3 sions of this act.
  - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
