IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter eighty-two of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven entitled "An Act relating to Madawaska Training School."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section three of chapter eighty-two of the

- 2 Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, is
- 3 hereby amended in the second line thereof, by substitut-
- 4 ing for the word "thirteen" the word 'sixteen', so that
- 5 said section, as amended, shall read as follows:
 - 'Section 3. To defray the current expenses of said
- 7 school, the sum of sixteen hundred dollars is hereby

- 8 annually appropriated from the school funds of the State,
- 9 in the same manner 'as appropriations are made for the
- 10 other State normal schools.'
- SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent here-2 with are hereby repealed.
