STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT for the protection of Trout in Alder Stream in the
town of Corinna, in the County of Penobscot.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall catch, kill or destroy any
2 trout in Alder Stream in the town of Corinna, in the
3 county of Penobscot for a term of four years.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions
2 of this act shall pay a sum of five dollars, and one dollar
3 for every fish so taken to be recovered on complaint before
4 any trial justice in Penobscot county, one-half to the com-
5 plainant and one-half to the county.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
