IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

---

AN ACT for the protection of trout in Eagle Lake in the  
town of Eden, in the county of Hancock.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from  
2 fishing for or taking any trout from Eagle lake in the  
3 town of Eden in the County of Hancock, from the first day  
4 of October in each year to the first day of May following  
5 for a period of four years.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions  
2 of this act shall be punished by a fine of five dollars for  
3 the offence, and a further penalty of one dollar for each  
4 trout so taken, to be recovered on complaint before any  
5 trial justice in said county, one-half to the complainant  
6 and one-half to the said County of Hancock.
