STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT for the protection of fish in Hobbs Pond and its
tributaries in the town of Hope, in the County of Knox.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from
2 fishing or taking fish of any kind, in any manner from the
3 Hobbs pond, or any of its tributaries, in the town of
4 Hope, in the County of Knox, between the first day of
5 October, and the first day of July following, of each year
6 for the period of four years.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions
2 of this act, shall be liable to a penalty of ten dollars
3 for the offense, and a further penalty of one dollar for
4 each fish taken in violation hereof, to be recovered on

5 complaint before any trial justice, or municipal or police
6 court, in said County of Knox; one-half to complainant,
7 and one-half to said County of Knox.
