STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to Chapter 70 of the Revised Statutes,
relating to Insolvency.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

No action shall be maintained in any court in this State,
2 against any inhabitant of this State who has obtained a
3 discharge from his debts under the insolvent laws of this
4 State, upon any claim or demand of any name, kind or
5 nature, that would have been discharged by said insolvency
6 proceedings if proved against said estate.
