STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT relative to the care of deposits made with the
State Treasurer in trust.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Insurance companies making deposits with
2 the State treasurer under sections fifty-seven to sixty-three
3 of the Revised Statutes and acts additional thereto, shall
4 pay five dollars to the State treasurer for every change in
5 securities made as therein provided.

SECT. 2. The State treasurer may expend each year a
2 sum not exceeding two hundred dollars, for such extra
3 clerical assistance as he may deem necessary in the care

4 and custody of the deposits made with him in trust by
5 such corporations and organizations as are required by
6 their charters or other laws of this State to make deposits
7 in trust with said treasurer.

SECT. 3. The amount expended under the authority of
2 the preceding section, shall be assessed in the month of
3 April of each year by the board of State assessors, upon
4 the several corporations and organizations making such
5 deposits, in proportion to the amount of their deposits at
6 the close of the year next preceding said assessment, and
7 the assessment so made shall be payable to the State
8 treasurer on the first day of July next after the assess-
9 ment is made. The amount on deposit by each of such
10 corporations or organizations upon which the tax is to be
11 assessed, shall be certified by the State treasurer to the
12 board of State assessors, in the month of March of each
13 year.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
