STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

An ACT relating to non-residents taking certain Fish in State waters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for non-residents to
- 2 use any fishing steamer for the purpose of catching mack-
- 3 erel, herring or menhaden in the waters of this State for
- 4 the purpose of supplying the markets of other states under
- 5 a penalty not to exceed five hundred dollars for each
- 6 offence to be recovered in an action of debt.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
