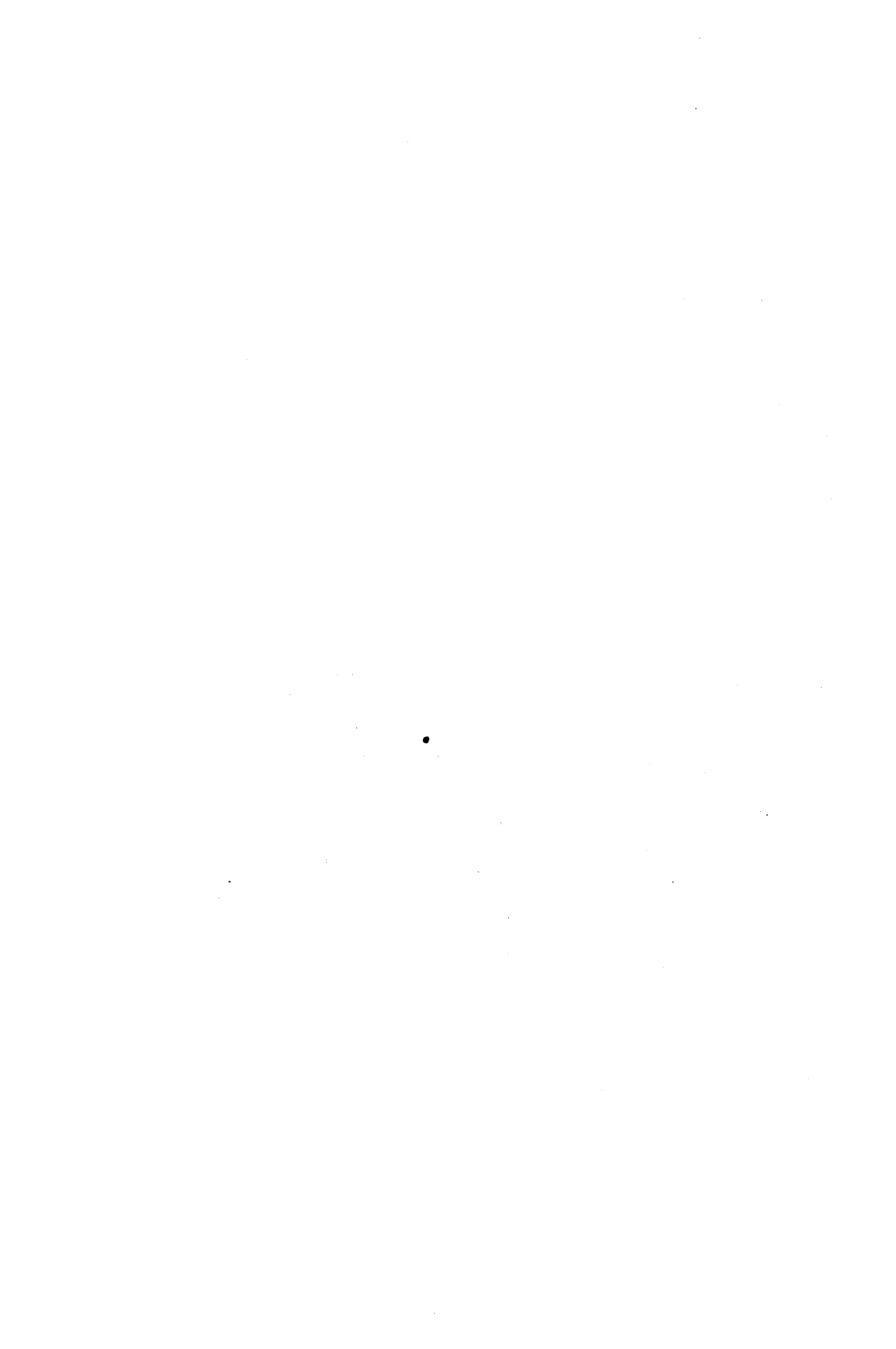

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the City of Bangor.

Resolved, That there be paid by the treasurer of state,
2 out of the school funds of the current year, to the city of
3 Bangor, the sum of eight hundred forty-eight dollars and
4 ninety-eight cents; it being a balance equitably due said
5 city as its proportion of the school funds for the year
6 eighteen hundred ninety-one.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The municipal officers of the city of Bangor failed to make their fiscal returns on or before the first day of July as required by law. In consequence thereof the state treasurer apportioned the school money upon the basis of the year before reduced by ten per cent, as the law prescribes, and the city thereby failed to receive the amount of money that it would otherwise have received, by the sum named in the accompanying resolve.
