IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-THREE.

---

AN ACT for the protection of trout in the tributaries of  
Parlin pond and Lang pond in Somerset County.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No fish of any kind shall be taken from  
2 the inlets of Parlin and Lang ponds or from Parlin or  
3 Lang streams or their tributaries for the term of five years  
4 from the first day of May, 1893.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions  
2 of this act shall be liable to a penalty of ten dollars for  
3 the offence and a further penalty of one dollar for each  
4 fish so taken to be recovered on complaint before any trial  
5 justice in Somerset county.
