STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to Expenditure of School Moneys.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No moneys raised by towns or apportioned
2 to towns from the State treasury for the support of common
3 schools, shall be expended in any school not wholly and
4 directly under the direction and control of the school officers
5 of the town in which said school is located, and the disci-
6 pline and the instruction of which is not in the English
7 language.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent here-
2 with, are hereby repealed.
