STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT authorizing the Metallic Setting Company to Change
the Par Value of its Stock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. That the Metallic Setting Company, a cor-
2 poration organized under the general laws of the State of
3 Maine, be and is hereby authorized, by a majority vote
4 of its stockholders, at any meeting of the corporation
5 called for that purpose, to change the par value of its
6 shares of stock from one hundred dollars to ten dollars,
7 and to increase the number of shares in said stock to cor-
8 respond with such change in the par value of its shares,
9 *provided* no reduction is made in the amount of its capital
10 stock.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
