STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT to set off from the town of Greenwood lot numbered
thirteen in the fifth range of lots and annex the same to the
town of Woodstock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All that part of the town of Greenwood,
2 known and described as lot numbered thirteen, in the fifth
3 range of lots in said town, together with the inhabitants
4 thereof, is hereby set off from said town of Greenwood
5 and annexed to the town of Woodstock.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
