IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

AN ACT in relation to the sale of Blooded Stock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person, employed by the owner of

- 2 blood animals, may sell the same as auctioneer at public
- 3 auction, whether licensed by municipal officers or not.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
