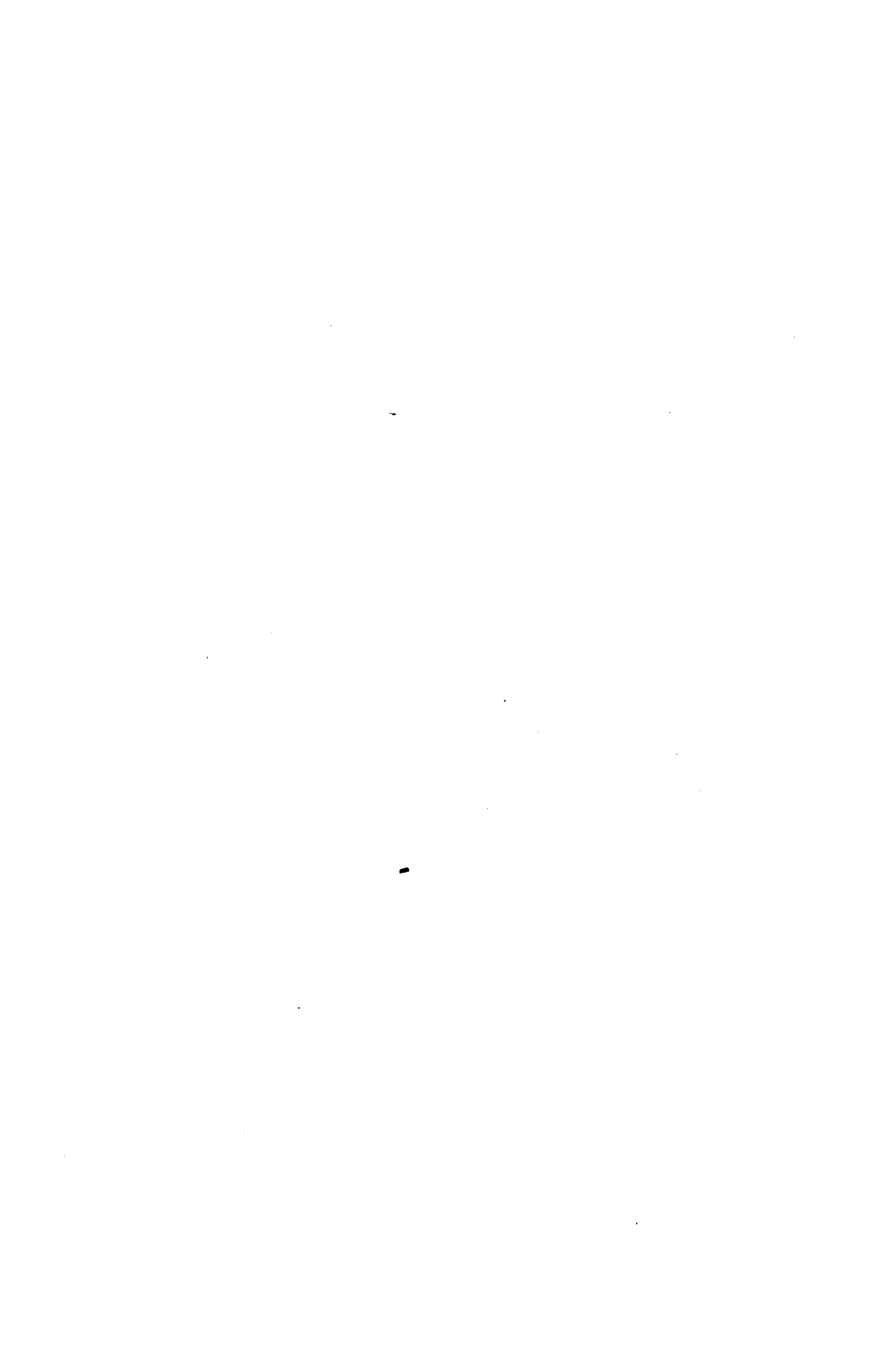
AN ACT for the Protection of Fish in King and Bartlett
Lakes in King and Bartlett township in Somerset county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from
2 taking fish of any kind, in any manner through the ice in
3 King and Bartlett lakes, known as "Big King" and "Little
4 King," or either of them, in King and Bartlett township,
5 in Somerset county, for the term of four years from the
6 date of the approval of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions
2 of this act shall be liable to a penalty of ten dollars for the

3 offense, and a further penalty of one dollar for each fish so
4 taken, to be recovered on complaint before any trial
5 justice in Somerset county, one-half to the use of the com-
6 plainant and the other half to the use of said county.
