## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

Resolved, That there be paid to the trustees of the Maine 2 State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts the 3 sum of twelve thousand (\$12,000) for the use of said 4 college for the years one thousand eight hundred and 5 ninety-three (1893) and one thousand eight hundred and 6 ninety-four (1894) to be expended according to the fol-7 lowing summary:
