## STATE OF MAINE.

---

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

---

*Resolved,* That there be paid to the trustees of the Maine  
2 State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts the  
3 sum of twelve thousand (\$12,000) for the use of said  
4 college for the years one thousand eight hundred and  
5 ninety-three (1893) and one thousand eight hundred and  
6 ninety-four (1894) to be expended according to the fol-  
7 lowing summary :

8 Furnishings for Wingate Hall, including	
9 cases, desks, chairs, drawing tables, &c.,	\$2,500 00
10 Enbankment for target practice,	600 00
11 Improvement of campus,	2,500 00
12 Potting and storage room for forcing house,	500 00

13	For agricultural department, painting of	
14	buildings, a silo, new floors in stable, &c.,	\$600 00
15	Apparatus for dairy house,	150 00
16	Apparatus for department of mechanical	
17	engineering, lathes, &c.,	1,750 00
18	Apparatus for department of civil engineering,	
19	testing machine and hydraulic apparatus,	1,300 00
20	Apparatus for department of natural history,	1,500 00
21	Apparatus for department of chemistry,	600 00
22	Total,	<u>\$12,000 00</u>

*Provided, however,* that no part of the above sum shall  
 24 be used or expended for any other purposes than those  
 25 mentioned in the above summary.
